### **Software Developer at Vencomatic Group**, Duizel – Juli 2021 to Nov. 2022

During my time as an entry level factory worker at Vencosteel (part of VCM Group) I was scouted as a software development talent and was offered to try out for a position as Software Developer at Vencomatic. I showed great promise and learned quickly with the help of my colleagues within the small software team present there at the time. Within a couple of weeks, I was developing full-stack web-apps nearly entirely independently. Beyond the standard web-dev fundamentals, our stack included C#, Azure, ASP.NET, and Razor. As my skills improved, I worked on increasingly complex infrastructure and business-automation tools – the most prominent of which being the '*infotool*' which serves as the main interface to their ERP backend to this day.
